## What are Chevening Scholarships?

The UK Government's **global scholarship programme**, funded by the FCO and partner organisations.

Available in over 160 countries and territories, the scholarships support one-year master's degrees in any subject and at any UK university.



## Who are Chevening Scholarships aimed at?

Chevening Scholars have ambition and leadership potential, a strong academic background, and have strong interpersonal skills.

Chevening Scholars tend to rise to **prominent positions** in their countries, and in their chosen fields.



#### Who should apply?

In order to submit an eligible application, you must:

- Be a citizen of Thailand
- Hold an undergraduate degree
- Have at least two years' work experience
- Not have previously received UK government funding to study in the UK



#### Further eligibility criteria

Before being awarded a scholarship, selected candidates must also:

- Meet the Chevening English language requirement (IELTS 6.5)
- Hold an unconditional offer from at least one of their three course choices



# What does a Chevening Scholarship cover?

- Fully covered\* tuition fees
- A living allowance at a set rate (for one individual)
- An economy return flight to the UK
- Additional grants to cover essential expenditure

\* There is a global Chevening fee cap of £18,000 for MBAs


For the 2017/2018 academic year, around 1,500 scholarships will be awarded to scholars from over 160 countries and territories.
